Shakespearience: ON YOUR STAGE

“*ET TU, SHAKESPEARE?*” is an hour long show that teaches high school students about Shakespeare’s time, theatre and plays through performing excerpts from his various works. Additionally, the original script - written by the troupe - incorporates Shakespeare’s scenes and information about the Bard in such a way that students can’t help but laugh and be entertained by it, while being exposed to culture and information while doing so. Following the performance, the troupe of three actors will stay on-stage to provide and interactive “talkback” with the students. This is an invaluable addition to the performance that encourages critical thinking and curious questions from the students. All 37 of Shakespeare’s works will be touched upon.



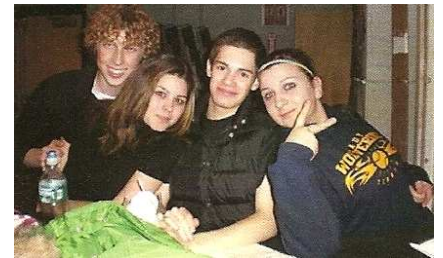
Shakespearience: IN YOUR CLASSROOM



This combines a performance of “*ET TU, SHAKESPEARE?*” PLUS 3 fun and “action-packed” in-class workshops in which students will work alongside actors in exercises addressing iambic pentameter, sound and meaning, and images. The text for the exercises are customized to the current play studied in your class and then rocked out, Shakespeare style! Workshops can be done back to back in one day or on three consecutive days.

Shakespearience: THE MASTER RESIDENCY

What’s that? You aren’t satisfied with just a visit? During a Master Residency our SDP actors come to your school and perform, “*ET TU, SHAKESPEARE?*” Then they infiltrate your classroom for 6 workshops where they address such topics as Shakespeare’s use of punctuation, antithesis, iambic pentameter as well as performance and creativity, to bring out their inner “Will”. Using techniques that are sure to have your students say, “May the Bard be with you,” as opposed to “Peace out, Shakespeare,” these six workshops culminate in a 50 minute presentation that students, along with the SDP actors, will perform for their peers and community. It is a Shakespearience not to be missed!



Shakespearience: THE MONOLOGUE MASTER CLASS



Ideal for any English class or drama club! This Master Class takes an intimate look at some of Shakespeare’s greatest monologues. Due to time, we like to limit the number of student performers in this class (but encourage others to observe). Students will be asked to come to the class with memorized monologues and, with the guidance of one of our actors, dissect and mold these pieces into independent masterpieces.
